Publication Ethics and Malpractice Statement

The International Conference on Advanced Communication, Energy and Big Data (ICACEBD-25) is committed to maintaining the highest standards of publication ethics. Duties of Authors

Authorship of the Paper: Authorship should be limited to those who have made a significant contribution to the conception, design, execution, or interpretation of the reported study.

Disclosure and Conflicts of Interest: All authors should disclose any financial or other substantive conflicts of interest that might influence the results or interpretation of their manuscript.

Duties of Reviewers

Confidentiality: Reviewers must treat all manuscripts received for review as confidential documents.

Objectivity: Reviews should be conducted objectively, with clear and constructive feedback.

Acknowledgment of Sources: Reviewers should identify relevant published work that has not been cited by the authors.

Duties of Editors

Fair Play: Editors should evaluate manuscripts for their intellectual content without regard to race, gender, sexual orientation, religious belief, ethnic origin, citizenship, or political philosophy of the authors.

Confidentiality: Editors must not disclose any information about a submitted manuscript to anyone other than the corresponding author, reviewers, potential reviewers, and the publisher.

Publication Decisions: Editors are responsible for deciding which of the articles submitted to the conference proceedings should be published, based on the validation of the work in question and its importance to researchers and readers.
